Session Purpose: The aim of this session is to recognize and understand how the Holy Spirit works in our lives.

• Without the Holy Spirit, most of the essentials of the Christian life would not happen (John 16:7)

O The Identity of the Holy Spirit

- The Scripture identifies the Holy Spirit in three essential ways:
 - 1) The Spirit is a real Person not a ghost, impersonal force or power.
 - He has personal characteristics (intellect, emotion, will)
 - He has personal names like *"the Helper"* (Jn 14:26; 15:26; 16:7)
 - He is referred to with personal pronouns (*"He" –* Jn. 15:26; 16:7, 17-18)
 - He does work that only persons can do (teach-Jn 14:26; reprove-Jn 16:8; intercede-Rom. 8:26; lead-Rom. 8:14; witness-Rom. 8:16)
 - 2) The Spirit is the third co-equal member of the Triune Godhead. There is one God who exists in three co-existent, co-equal, co-eternal Persons: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit
 - 3) The Spirit is God sharing the divine names, attributes, works, authority, and equality

• The Illustrations about the Holy Spirit (clothing, dove, pledge, fire, oil, seal, water, wind)

• The Instigations of the Holy Spirit

1) He instigates your _____ in coming to Christ

- He <u>inspired</u> the Scriptures so you can learn & apply the gospel story that saves (2 Peter 1:21; John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13; 1 Jn 4:6; 5:6)
- He <u>convicts</u> you of sin, righteousness & judgment (John 16:7-11; 3:20)

2) He instigates your _____ to Christ.

- He <u>initiates</u> your new life "by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the HS" (Titus 3:5), being born again (John 3:5), resurrects your dead heart (Jn 6:63; 2 C. 3:6; Jn 6:63; Eph. 2:5; Col. 2:13)
- He <u>indwells</u> you (1 Cor. 6:19; Rom. 8:9) personally (Jn 14:16-17), permanently (Eph. 1:13) and powerfully (Eph. 3:16)
- He <u>immerses</u> you into the body of Christ (I C. 12:13). This is the baptism in/with/by the Holy Spirit (Mt. 3:11; Mk 1:8, Lk 3:16, Jn 1:33, Acts 1:5, 11:16; 1 Cor. 12:13) which happens at the moment of belief (John 7:37-39, Acts 11:17) to all believers
- He <u>adopts</u> you into His family (Rom. 8:15)
- He <u>seals</u> you to guarantee your salvation (2 Cor. 1:22; Eph. 1:14)
- He <u>unites</u> you to Christ (Rom. 8:9-11)

3) He instigates your _____ in Christ.

- He <u>glorifies</u> Jesus Christ (John 16:13-15; 7:39)
- He <u>instructs</u> you with divine <u>truth</u> (1 Cor. 2:10-16) as the "Spirit of truth" (4x John 14:17, 15:26, 16:13, 1 Jn. 5:7) and <u>guides</u> us into all truth (Jn. 16:13) and <u>reminds</u> you to "<u>listen</u>" to what the Spirit says (Rev. 2-3)
- He <u>influences</u> your sanctification (Rm. 8:2; 1 Cor. 6:11; Rom. 15:16; 1 Pet. 1:2)
- He <u>motivates</u> you through eight specific commands that demands your <u>cooperation</u> so you can grow.
 - 1. You avoid <u>grieving</u> Him with your sin (Eph. 4:30-32).
 - You avoid <u>quenching</u> Him with an unwilling, unyielding spirit (1 Thess. 5:19).
 - 3. You <u>pray</u> in the HS by ordering your prayers according to His will (Jude 20; Eph. 6:18).
 - 4. You are to be "*filled* with the HS" (Eph. 5:18)
 - 5. You "<u>walk</u> by the Spirit" (Gal. 5:16-25).
 - 6. You "<u>take up</u> the sword of the Spirit" (Eph. 6:17) to defend yourself against Satan's demonic forces.
 - 7. You <u>use</u> your ministry gifts (of the Spirit) to serve and bless the body of Christ (1 Pet. 4:10-11; 1 Cor. 12:7)
 - 8. You are diligent to "preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace:" (Eph. 4:3).

- He empowers you to live the Christian life: 5 key energizing empowerments:
 - 1. He enables you to witness courageously (Acts 1:8).
 - 2. He enables us to worship correctly (Phil. 3:3 "who worship in the Spirit of God...")
 - 3. He enables us to work competently (1 Cor. 12:7: 1 Pet. 4:11-12)
 - 4. He enables us to win confidently against sin (Rm. 8:2; 1 Jn. 3:20; 2 Cor. 3:18; Eph. 4:30 Rom. 8:12-14; John 14:16, 26, 15:26, 16:7; Acts 9:31).
 - 5. He enables us to walk consistently (Gal. 5:16)
- 4) He instigates your _____ in Christ (Rom. 8:11)
